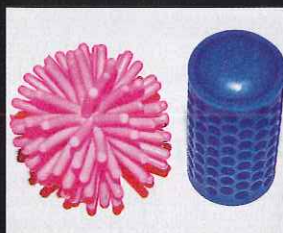




LIGHTFIELD LESS LETHAL RESEARCH

Lightfield is one of the few companies that sell less-lethal impact and other munitions to civilians. The Lightfield Star and Starlite rounds are like koosh balls on steroids. The Nova-DR is a muzzle blast diversionary load which can be fired through a 12 gauge shotgun. Imagine an outdoor threat such as a trespasser who refuses to depart your property and threatens bodily harm to you or your loved ones. With the Nova-DR you can fire into the air, providing a loud, non-deadly warning to the suspect. The Nova-DR can also

be used for animal threats. Lightfield has an extensive inventory of products in its less lethal line. Everything from the aforementioned to 12 gauge rubber slugs, double ball, rubber buckshot, breaching rounds and more. All are available to both police and civilians. (litfld.com)



PUT A LITTLE PEPPER ON IT

The PepperBlaster and PepperBlaster II from Kimber have been out for a few years. The two-shot OC pepper launchers fit comfortably in the back pocket of your jeans or a coat pocket while you're out on an evening stroll to provide a non-deadly self-defense option. The PepperBlaster products can fire two "balls" of 10% oleoresin capsicum with 2.4% capsaicinoid content into the face of an attacker covering the chest to the top of the head at a distance out to 13 feet. New carry options from Kimber for 2013 are a black Cordura nylon belt carry case, a thermo-plastic belt clip and a red laser aiming device all for less than \$25 each. The Cordura case is a belt holster for your model I or II PB - PepperBlaster to facilitate quicker access. It features a snap cover to carry your PB discreetly but instantly accessible. The thermoplastic belt clip is designed for the PB II (the original PB has an integral belt clip.) The PB II design is more "gun like" with a small handgrip and sights. The belt clip allows the PB II to be carried for a conventional draw or crossdraw. The new laser clip provides both an aiming mechanism as well as a visible warning to a potential attacker that bad things will happen if they continue to advance towards you. The PepperBlaster I and II are smart and effective designs for a less-lethal self-defense option. The belt holster case, plastic belt clip and red laser improve their effectiveness even more in a low-cost option. (kimberamerica.com)



ENLIGHTEN YOUR ATTACKER

It is called a Zaplight, and it is flashlight that you can grab to find your way through the dark if something goes bump in the night, but the Zaplight offers a little more. A good tactical flashlight combined with a handgun is a traditional pairing when clearing rooms for a potential threat. With the Zaplight you have a 150-lumen LED light to illuminate your path but the front of the light also houses the contacts for a selectively activated 1-million-volt stun

gun that has multiple operation, from a warning with arcing and sound to sustained contact which will knock most people to the ground. As noted by the manufacturer, the best points of contact for maximum effect are the upper shoulder, below the ribcage, or the upper hip areas. Rechargeable and always at the ready for home defense, the Zaplight offers an effective less-than-lethal defensive option. Available from Cabela's and other sporting goods retailers.

RUGER NON LETHAL DETERRENTS

Ruger is not the first gun manufacturer to understand the value of having a less-lethal product, and it's teamed up with a well-designed product by Tornado. The Ultra Pepper Spray System includes a well-designed belt clip carrier that allows instant access via a push-button release tab. Once the OC spray unit is released from the carrier a 125-decibel siren begins screaming to alert others that something is going on. The unit includes a strobing light to disorient the attacker as well as an OC spray rated out to 15 feet that delivers a stream of 2 million Scoville Heat Units of pepper product. The Stealth Pepper Spray System has the same quality spray but no siren or strobing light. There are other products in the Tornado line now carried by Ruger, such as Lockdown for law enforcement and other civilian models. Available through Ruger's firearm distributors and online as well, Ruger is now offering an alternative mode of force to its quality firearms when deadly force is not called for. (gettornado.com)



THINK PINK

For 2013 Mace has added to its pink products in a big way. The maximum-strength Hot Pink pepper spray is now available in two additional models. The Mini model is refillable, discreet and easy to carry on a keychain. The Jogger has Mace's unique flip and grip design with the added feature of an adjustable hand strap, making it convenient for walking or jogging. Through the Mace Cares program, a portion of proceeds from Hot Pink products will be donated to organizations that support victims of violent crimes, domestic violence and breast cancer. Mace manufactures a wide variety of other OC pepper formulas in streams, cone sprays and gels. Most include UV dye, which marks an assailant for identification. In addition to pepper sprays, Mace offers other products for personal safety, such as the Screecher line of personal alarms and Flasher safety lights.
